  - Financial requirements
  - Quality Management

4. The fourth part of the questionnaire allowed partners to include any other comment or suggestion regarding all those aspects not dealt with in the questionnaire, or aspects that should be taken into further account.

### Evaluation of the questionnaire

After the deadline iTStudy collected the answers, summarized them and made this evaluation.

Each partner has given a specific valuation, considering a 1-to-5 scale (where 1 means "stongly agree", 2 means "agree", 3 means "don't know" and 4 means "disagree" and 5 means "strongly disagree". According to this, the most significant results are described.
