Answers to the evaluation questions

The conference was very successful according to the feedbacks received by the participants.

The evaluation form was completed by all of the participants. The results are summarized on the charts below:



77 % of the participants were teachers and 23 % directors.



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Participants were absolutely satisfied with the organization, the environment and the presentations of the conference.



Most of the participants (85%) think that the conference met their expectations.



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Most of the participants (92%) got answers to their questions during the conference.

For the open question: "What is your opinion on the present situation of the quality management of the Hungarian Vocational Education" the answers consistently stated that it needs reconsideration and development.

As a conclusion we can state that the project and its trainings and online platform could be answers for a gap experienced in this field in VET, and we hope that it will satisfy needs and expectations.
